- **Dinosaur Dice-** First, we need to make the dice. Follow the instructions on the attached sheet. Roll the dice! See what dinosaur it lands on. Can you say there is/there are spikes/ tails/legs etc.? Can you make a sentence in the past? Next, mark it off on the corresponding chart. First dinosaur to make it to the top of the chart wins! Who do you think will win?
- **Acrostic Poem-** Let's see your creativity! Create an acrostic poem about dinosaurs. An acrostic poem is a poem that the first letter of each line usually spells the topic of the poem.
